

Contractor Licenses and Building Permits

Contractors must register with the borough prior to performing any work in Conshohocken. The process verifies that the contractor has liability insurance and for those with employees, workmen's compensation insurance has been provided. Before you hire a contractor verify that he or she is registered with the borough.

Please note that the property owner is ultimately responsible for the construction permit whether the owner or a contractor performs the work. If a contractor tells you that he or she will obtain the building permit, ask to see the permit before allowing the contractor to start work on your property. Remember the permit must be posted in a conspicuous location for the duration of the project.

To determine if your contractor is registered and/or has obtained a building permit, call Borough Hall and ask for the Code Enforcement Department.
